- 1. To use this form, you must be a person currently serving a sentence under a judgment against you in **state court**. If you wish to challenge the validity of a **federal judgment** of conviction and sentence, you should <u>not</u> use this form and instead file a motion under 28 U.S.C. § 2255 in the federal court which entered the judgment.
- 2. You may also use this form to challenge a state court judgment that imposed a sentence to be served in the future, but you must fill in the name of the state where the judgment was entered.
- 3. This petition must be legibly handwritten or typewritten and signed by the petitioner under penalty of perjury. If you make a false statement of a material fact, you may be prosecuted for perjury.
- 4. All questions must be answered concisely in the proper space on the form. If needed, you may attach additional pages. If you attach additional pages, number the pages and identify which section of the petition is being continued. Do <u>NOT</u> write on the back of any page.
- 5. Do not use this form unless you were convicted in a state court in one of the following Alabama counties: BIBB, BLOUNT, CALHOUN, CHEROKEE, CLAY, CLEBURNE, COLBERT, CULLMAN, DEKALB, ETOWAH, FAYETTE, FRANKLIN, GREENE, JACKSON, JEFFERSON, LAMAR, LAUDERDALE, LAWRENCE, LIMESTONE, MADISON, MARION, MARSHALL, MORGAN, PICKENS, SHELBY, ST. CLAIR, SUMTER, TALLADEGA, TUSCALOOSA, WALKER, or WINSTON.
- 6. In order for your petition to be filed, it must be accompanied by the \$5.00 filing fee. If you are unable to pay the filing fee, you may petition the court to proceed as an indigent party. An Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* is included with this petition.
- 7. No more than one petitioner may be named in a petition. Each petitioner must file a separate petition and pay the filing fee or submit an Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis*.
- 8. Only judgments entered by one court may be challenged in a single petition. If you seek to challenge judgments entered by different courts, you must file separate petitions as to each court.
- 9. You must include in this petition all grounds for relief from the conviction or sentence that you challenge, and you must state the facts that support each ground. If you fail to set forth all the grounds in this petition, you may be barred from presenting additional grounds at a later date.
- 10. <u>Capital Cases</u>: If you are under a sentence of death and are indigent, you may be entitled to the assistance of counsel and should request the appointment of counsel.
- 11. You must immediately notify the court in writing of any change of address. If you do not, the court may dismiss your case.

 - (A) the date on which the judgment became final by the conclusion of direct review or the expiration of the time for seeing such review;
 - (B) the date on which the impediment to filing an application created by state action in violation of the Constitution or laws of the United States is removed, if the applicant was prevented from filing by such state action;
 - (C) the date on which the constitutional right asserted was initially recognized by the Supreme Court and made retroactively applicable to cases on collateral review; or
 - (D) the date on which the factual predicate of the claim or claims presented could have been discovered through the exercise of due diligence.
- (2) The time during which a properly filed application for state post-conviction or other collateral review with respect to the pertinent judgment or claim is pending shall not be counted toward any period of limitation under this subsection.
