RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR TRANSCRIPTS )  
BY OFFICIAL REPORTERS )

As authorized by the Judicial Conference of the United States at its September 2007, March 2011, March 2018, September 2021, September 2022, and September 2023 meetings and after considering the rates charged for comparable services in state courts, the United States District Court for the Northern District of Alabama sets the following rates for transcripts by the official court reporters in this court:

	<b>Original Per Page</b>	<b>First Copy to Each Party Per Page</b>	<b>Each Add'l Copy to the Same Party Per Page</b>
<b>30-Day Transcript (Ordinary)</b> A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.00	\$1.00	\$.70
<b>14-Day Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.70	\$1.00	\$.70
<b>7-Day Transcript (Expedited)</b> A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$5.35	\$1.00	\$.70
<b>3-Day Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered within three (3) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$6.00	\$1.20	\$.85
<b>Next-Day Transcript (Daily)</b> A transcript to be delivered on the calendar day following receipt of the order (regardless of whether that calendar day is a weekend or holiday), prior to the normal opening hour of the clerk's office.	\$6.70	\$1.35	\$1.00
<b>2-Hour Transcript (Hourly)</b> A transcript of proceedings to be delivered within two (2) hours from receipt of the order.	\$8.00	\$1.35	\$1.00

**Realtime Transcript**

A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following receipt of the order.

One feed,<sup>1</sup> \$3.40      N/A      N/A  
per page; two-to-four  
two-to-four feeds,  
\$2.35 per page;  
five or more feeds,  
\$1.65 per page.

Orders placed on or before the day of the proceeding will be batched together for purposes of determining the number of feeds; and subsequent orders will be charged at the lowest page rate assessed on the previous orders.

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 753(f), no fee shall be charged for a copy of a transcript delivered to the clerk for the records of the court.

These rates take effect for all transcript orders received on or after December 1, 2023.
