GENERAL ORDER NO.

The court ORDERS as follows:

Limited-scope representation in the Northern District of Alabama is authorized in civil cases as follows:

(a) *Permitted* in accordance with Rule 1.2.(c) of the Alabama Rules of Professional Conduct in civil court proceedings.


(b) *Motion*. If specifically so stated in a motion requesting limited-scope representation filed and served prior to or simultaneously with the filing of his or her initial appearance, an attorney's role in a civil case may be limited as set forth in the motion, if approved by the Court.

(c) *Termination*. The attorney's role terminates without the necessity of leave of court upon the attorney's filing of a notice of completion of a limited-scope representation with a certification of service on the client. Upon the attorney's filing of the notice of completion, the clerk is authorized to terminate the appearance of the attorney.

(d) *Service*. Service on an attorney providing limited-scope representation is required only for matters within the scope of the representation as set forth in the notice.

The effective date of this General Order is November 18, 2016.
