If admitted to practice before the Supreme Court of Alabama and before the U. S. District Court for the Middle and/or Southern District of Alabama, you may be admitted to this bar by filing an application, an application fee of \$ 200.00, effective March 1, 2009, and a certificate of good standing from either federal court.

Others must be admitted to practice before the Supreme Court of Alabama and residents of, or regularly engaged in the practice of law in, this state. Admission will be upon motion of a member of this court's bar (oral or written) or *sua sponte* under special circumstances with prior court approval, following submission of a completed application, payment of the \$ 200.00 fee and administration of the oath of office.

The application and fee must be filed with the Clerk no later than one day prior to the scheduled admission date.
