
WAIVER OF DETENTION HEARING

After having been advised by my attorneys and the court that I have a right to a hearing on the Government's motion to detain me, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3142, and that the burden of proof at such hearing would be on the Government to prove by clear and convincing evidence that there exist no bond conditions or combination of conditions under which I could be released pending trial, which conditions would reasonably assure that I appear for trial and all related proceedings, that I surrender for sentence (if one is imposed), and that I will not be a danger to the community or some person in the community, I hereby waive (give up) my right to such a hearing. I understand that by doing so the Government's motion to detain me will be granted and I will remain in the custody of the United States Marshal until the trial of my case.

I make this waiver freely, voluntarily, and with a full understanding of its consequences. I have not been threatened, coerced, or promised anything in return for this waiver.
