**SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER REGARDING RULE 16(b)(1)(C) NOTICES
AND AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER**

In light of the government's response to the court's order of September 28, 2004, defendant's motion to extend time for filing Rule 16 summaries is extended until December 1, 2004, with the understanding that the government will provide all necessary materials in order for defendant to file expert witness summaries by November 1, 2004.¹

The scheduling order must be modified in light of this most recent delay to reflect the following deadlines:

- December 1, 2004 Defendant to produce to government summaries of all opinions and testimony as defined by FRE 702, 703, and 705.
- December 15, 2004 Agreed jury questionnaire due; any additional questions not agreed to also will be filed with objections to the

question and supporting arguments stated beneath each.

December 20, 2004 Daubert Motions due.

January 20, 2005 Responses to Daubert Motions due.

January 31, 2005 All other pending motions, including motions in limine due.

February 28, 2005 Responses to all other pending motions, including motions in limine due.

All other deadlines outlined in the court's June 23, 2004 order that have not expired remain in effect.²
