
The Court originally entered a General Order on March 17, 2020 that in part, stayed all then unexpired deadlines and briefing schedules in civil cases. That stay was continued by a General Order entered on April 13, 2020.

After carefully considering the developing circumstances in the Northern District of Alabama, it is appropriate for this Court to terminate the previously entered stay.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The stay of the unexpired deadlines and briefing schedules in civil cases originally entered on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2020, is terminated. Regardless, the district and magistrate judges are free to reinstate the stay or some version of a stay based upon the circumstances of their individual cases. All other provisions of the March 17, 2020 General Order, unless previously modified, remain in full force and effect.
