PEREMPTORY JURY STRIKES OF DEFENDANT

A twelve person jury will be selected from the first twenty-eight jurors remaining after any challenges for cause are granted. You may strike peremptorily up to ten of those twenty-eight jurors. The first twelve of those jurors not struck by either party will constitute the jury. Any Batson challenge which is upheld will result in the loss of a peremptory strike. No additional strikes will be allowed.
