As authorized by the Judicial Conference of the United States at its September 2007, March 2011, and March 2018 meetings and after considering the rates charged for comparable services in state courts, the United States District Court for the Northern District of Alabama hereby sets the following rates for transcripts by the official reporters in this court:

	<b>Original</b>	<b>First Copy to Each Party</b>	<b>Each Add'l Copy to the Same Party</b>
<b>Ordinary Transcript (30 day)</b> A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$3.65	\$ .90	\$.60
<b>14-Day Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.25	\$ .90	\$.60
<b>Expedited Transcript (7 day)</b> A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.85	\$ .90	\$.60
<b>3-Day Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered within three (3) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$5.45	\$1.05	\$.75
<b>Daily Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered on the calendar day following receipt of the order (regardless of whether that calendar day is a weekend or holiday), prior to the normal opening hour of the clerk's office.	\$6.05	\$1.20	\$.90
<b>Hourly Transcript</b> A transcript of proceedings to be delivered within two (2) hours from receipt of the order.	\$7.25	\$1.20	\$.90
<b>Realtime Transcript</b> A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following receipt of the order.	One feed, <sup>1</sup> \$3.05 per page; two-to-four feeds, \$2.10 per page; five or more feeds, \$1.50 per page.		



<sup>1</sup>A realtime "feed" is the electronic data flow from the court reporter to the computer of each person or party ordering and receiving the realtime transcription in the courtroom.

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 753(f), no fee shall be charged for a copy of a transcript delivered to the clerk for the records of the court.

These rates take effect for all transcript orders received on or after March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
